

## All Canada Sheep Classic 2013 Rules

- 1. Consignors must be current (2013) members of the Canadian Sheep Breeders' Association;
- 2. All animals must be born the property of the consignor and be purebreds registered with the CSBA;
- 3. Breeders may enter as many ewes as they wish. Each ram entered requires an entry of one ewe, but the ewe does not have to be the same breed as the ram;
- 4. Animals must show in order to sell, and all animals shown must be offered for sale, unless disqualified due to injury or sickness;
- 5. **Please send entries to the office of the Canadian Sheep Breeders' Association**. Entries may be mailed to the CSBA at RR2, Site 7, Box 46 Bluffton, AB T0C 0M0, faxed to 1-877-207-2541 or emailed/scanned to office@sheepbreeders.ca
- 6. There is a \$25 entry fee for each animal. For each animal that is inspected by the culling committee at the Classic, breeders will be refunded \$15 of the entry fee;
- 7. Closing date for entries is April 12, 2013. Entries received in the CSBA office after this date will be assessed a late entry fee of \$25 in addition to the regular entry fee. No entries will be accepted after April 26, 2013;
- 8. Entry fees may be paid by cheque, VISA or MasterCard. Cheques should be made payable to the Canadian Sheep Breeders' Association and mailed to the CSBA office at RR 2, Site 7, Box 46 Bluffton, AB T0C 0M0. Credit card information may be included with entry forms or phoned (1-866-956-1116) or faxed (1-877-207-2541) to the CSBA office;
- 9. Entries that have not been paid for by April 26, 2013 will not be included in the sale catalogue;
- 10. A CSBA registration certificate, properly signed for transfer, must be provided for each entry to the sale committee by Friday, June 28, 2013;
- 11. Substitutions are only allowed **within the same class**. A maximum of two animals per breed, at a cost of \$5per animal, may be substituted. Junior lambs may be substituted at no cost, but are included in the total number of substitutions per breed that a breeder may make;
- 12. All animals will be subject to a check by a culling committee and veterinarian;
- 13. Consignors will show for ribbons only. Each breed shows separately:
- 14. Halters may be used. The exhibitor's dress code is black pants & white shirt;
- 15. The sale commission will be 15%, with the following exceptions: the minimum commission on animals that sell will be \$30 and the maximum commission on animals that sell will be \$150;
- 16. Reserve bids will be managed by the auctioneer. Amended February 26, 2013.
- 17. Failure to comply with the above rules will result in disqualification from the show and sale.



## All Canada Sheep Classic 2013 Classes

- 1. Yearling Ewe born September 1, 2011 to August 31, 2012.
- 2. Senior Ewe Lamb born September 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012.
- 3. Junior Ewe Lamb born January 1, 2013 or later.
- 4. Champion & Reserve Champion Ewe.
- 5. Yearling Ram born September 1, 2011 to August 31, 2012.
- 6. Senior Ram Lamb born September 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012.
- 7. Junior Ram Lamb born January 1, 2013 or later.
- 8. Champion & Reserve Champion Ram
- 9. Champion Flock 4 animals representing both sexes, previously shown in above classes, no entry or entry fee required.
- 10. Supreme Champion Ram.
- 11. Supreme Champion Ewe.
- 12. Supreme Champion Flock.

The following breeds should show in short fleece (less than 1 inch or 2.4 cm): Canadian Arcott, Outaouais Arcott, Rideau Arcott, Border Cheviot, Charollais, Clun Forest, Dorper, Dorset, Hampshire, Ile de France, North Country Cheviot, Oxford Down, Polypay, Romanov, Shropshire, Southdown, Suffolk and Texel. All sheep of any breed, born before January 1, 2013, must have been sheared after this date. All sheep must be clean. Sheep may be culled if deemed to have improper wool length or cleanliness.

- **❖** Entries received in the CSBA office after April 12, 2013 will be assessed a late entry fee of \$25 in addition to the regular entry fee.
- **❖** No entries will be accepted after April 26, 2013.
- **Entries that have not been paid by April 26, 2013 will not be included in the sale catalogue.**
