#### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

CLASS 1 Range Wool

\* Including Columbia, Rambouillet, Corriedale, Targhee, Merino

CLASS 2 Long Wool

\* Including Romney, Lincoln, Leicester, Cotswold, Coopworth

CLASS 3 All Down Breeds

\* Including Hampshire, Suffolk, Cheviot, Dorset, Texel, Arcott breeds, East Friesian and Charollais

CLASS 4 Other Speciality Wools

\* Including Icelandic, Shetland, Jacob, Karakul

CLASS 5 Crossbred Wools

\* From sheep which represent a combination of any two of Class 1, 2, 3 or 4. (e.g. Long Wool breed x Down breed)

#### **FLEECE COMPETITION DETAILS**

- 1. White and natural coloured fleeces from sheep in any Canadian province may be entered.
- 2. Fleeces are to be from animals owned by the exhibitor and be of no more than 15 months growth.
- 3. Where entries warrant, classes may be divided by colour, sex or age and judged accordingly.
- 4. Entry fee is \$5.00 per fleece.
- 5. Maximum of 2 entries per farm per category.
- 6. Deadline for entry forms is Friday, May 31, 2013.
- 7. Fleeces must be at the North Thompson Agriplex, 4872 Dunn Lake Road, Barriere, BC, V0E 1E0 no later than 12 Noon Friday, June 28, 2013. Deliveries to this location will be accepted starting Monday, June 24.
- 8. Fleeces can be shipped and timed to arrive only during the week of June 24 to 28 at the North Thompson Agriplex, address above.
- 9. Fleeces should be in the grease, clean and well prepared (skirted). Pack carefully to avoid damage en route and on removal from container.
- 10. Prizes, subject to sponsorship:

a. In each Class First; Second; Honourable Mention

b. Overall Supreme Champion Fleece; Reserve Champion Fleece

The Judge's decision in all placings will be final.

- 11. The 2013 All Canada Sheep Classic Fleece Competition is a project of the BC Purebred Sheep Breeders Association (BCPSBA). The BCPSBA and the Canadian Sheep Breeders' Association shall not be held liable for any loss or damage occurring to fleeces entered in this competition. Every effort will be made to take good care of the fleeces during the competition, display and auction time.
- 12. Disbursement of Fleeces:
  - ~ Entrants reserve the right to retain ownership of their fleece; such entries should be clearly marked as "**NOT FOR SALE**".
  - ~ All fleeces received without a NOT FOR SALE label will be offered For Sale by silent auction, after the judging has taken place.
  - ~ Each Sale Fleece will be weighed on location.
  - ~ Bids will be accepted in an amount per pound, for the entire fleece.
  - ~ A minimum bid will be established and published.
  - ~ Highest bid at closing will be accepted.
  - ~ Fleeces failing to receive a bid must be reclaimed by the owner.

- ~ Fleeces remain the property of the consignor until the completion of the sale.
- ~ The entire proceeds for the sale of fleeces will be paid out to the Consignors by the BCPSBA Treasurer within15 business days of the auction. No commission will be charged.
